Minutes of General Meeting

June 14, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Donna Brattin in the absence of President Barbara Laxson.

Minutes/Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report printed in the last newsletter was approved by the members.

The minutes printed in the last newsletter was approved by members. However, following the meeting Suzie Nairn informed me, Rita Fenn, that the announcement regarding the Samaritan Purse group which meets at the First Baptist Church in North Kansas City misstated the meeting times. They meet every Tuesday from 9:00 a.m. to noon. The official copy of the minutes has been corrected.

Old Business: Donna announced that we have not been successful filling the Assistant Second Vice President position. We have a member who has volunteered for this position and who is qualified via her membership in a prior guild. Our guild's officers have approved waving our minimum time as a member of our guild member requirement based on her prior experience. Our guild does have precedence for doing this before. A motion was made to approve Sandy Cerra for this position, and was approved by a show of hands.

Donna announced that two volunteers are immediately needed to assist Barbara Moyer in obtaining volunteers for officer position openings January 2023 and in presenting them to the members for approval. This is an urgent need. Contact Donna or Barbara if you are interested or have questions.

New Business: Donna Brattin has a friend who is no longer able to quilt and wants to donate her fabric for **charitable quilts**, Donna asked for help in transporting the bins of fabric so it can be made available to our members to make **charitable quilts**.

Shirley Green announced that there is a group "Hope and Quilts" sponsored by the Ukraine Children's Church World Services. They want to gift each Ukraine child who is relocated to the U.S. with a quilt. Shirley has information available at our membership desk or you may contact her directly. There is an August deadline. Shirley will be at the August Sew Bee meeting to accept any donations.

Members were reminded of our website and reminded of its address: northlandquiltersguild.com. Our website address will be added to the last page of our future newsletters.

Once again, we have purchased openings for up to 50 guild members to attend Global Quilt Connections online presentations. In the past 20-25 members have participated. This time there will be no pre-enrollment. An email will be sent to each member with information on the dates, times and sessions. Members can just log on individually and up to 50 people will be allowed to sign in each day. Watch for the email with details.

Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival 2023

I hope all of you have been checking the KCRQF website to see all the updates about the Festival.

At present, there are approximately 85 vendors with 75 booths left to fill. If there is a vendor that you would like to have at the Festival, you can send your suggestion to vendor@kcrqf.com.

There will be seven(7) classrooms, all with machines. There will be two rooms with longarm machines from Hand-iQuilter and Janome longarm machines from Quilters HQ.

Are any of you participating in the Showcase Challenge? If so, please let me know.

Tickets will be bought online this year. You will be able to purchase your ticket(s), buy merchandise and register for any classes at the same time. You will then print your ticket which will have a Bar Code at the bottom. The Overland Park Convention center will provide Bar Code readers. Ticket prices are \$15/day, \$30/3days or \$17 at the door. There will be a separate \$12 Saturday only ticket available which must be purchased ahead of time.

The Festival dates are June 15th, 16th, and 17th, 2023 at the Overland Park Convention Center, Overland Park, Kansas. Keep checking the KCRQF website, www.kcrqf.com, for updates.

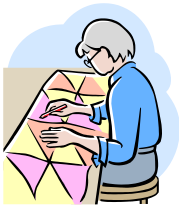
