Annual Retreat

The annual retreat for the Northland Quilters Guild will be on February 18-21, 2021. The retreat will be held at the Heartland Center (the usual place) on 45 Hwy and 435. The retreat will start at mid-day on Thursday and go through Sunday noon. The price for the three nights is \$160 which pays for your room and five meals. Each room has three twin beds and a private bath with shower. We have access to the sewing space 24 hours a day so if you sew late or early, you will be able to sew all you want. We will be taking reservations with a deposit at the first meeting we have this summer.

Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival

The KCRQF is still scheduled for next June 2021, for now. Our job for the show will be **Door Prizes** which is considered Minimum Involvement. Below is the option for distribution that was selected.

OPTION ONE: 50/50 split:

The first 50% of the profit would be split evenly between the 17 participating guilds.

The second 50% will be based on committee weights. Maximum involvement would be weighted at 1.5

Moderate involvement would be weighted at 1.25

Minimum involvement would be weighted at 1.

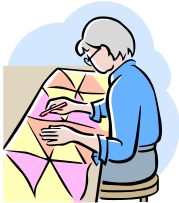
