

Previous minutes/newsletter approved with no changes.

Committee Reports:

Treasurer: No new information. Any receipts should be turned in.

Bazaar: Need more items. Our inventory is not nearly as much or as good as last year. There will be no meetings on the next two Tuesdays (June 27 and July 4).

Door Prizes: With only two vendors it may be a problem. We will need to ask for members to bring in item and take some from the Bazaar. Last year \$10 gift certificates for the Bazaar were made and a free membership was offered. Debbie Moore will check with Fabric Chic.

Publicity: Will send cards out now that Regional is over. After a discussion of business cards left over from Regional it was decided that we would wait to order more cards, they are done very quickly.

Quilt Registration: It is open, the link was sent out by Doris Torres on June 3rd. Several of us do not remember getting the link, but it was in the Nitetime Needlers June newsletter. We will request that Doris resends it now that the regional quilt show is over.

Signs: No updates, just a request to let her know if we need any new signs.

Silent Auction: Receiving items, still need more. No updates.

Special Exhibit: They have 21 or 22 registered. There is always room for more.

Sponsors: No updates.

Vendors: Little Red Hen will not be there due to a scheduling conflict. Lemon Thyme is definitely interested. All About Tie Dye may be interested.

Old and new business

There was some discussion about Facebook Accounts. There are still one or two showing up. Not sure what we can do about it.

The black drapes for the quilt show have been measured and folded so the measurement shows on top. This was done by Mary Cason, Thia Crawford, Debbie Moore, Melanie Vance and Sandy Cerra.

Sign Up Genius will need to put out in July. This is for all the volunteer jobs to run the show.

Additional electronic payment set up like we have would cost \$130. One that would need an app to run would cost \$40. It was decided that no more than it is needed we will send the patron to the Bazaar. We will leave instructions at the Admission Desk to that effect. We need to get our reservation in for the hot spot from Midcontinent Library as soon as possible. Karen Allen will check into the hot spot, if someone has already reserved it or not and reserve it if needed.

Roberta Waterfield has agreed to make floor pads for the quilt show, for when the quilt is so long that it rests on the floor. We have no extra fabric. Mary Cason will check to see if they can get a deal from Fabri-QUILTS on black fabric. The pads need to be a finished size of 18 x 90 inches. The original number of 12 has been dropped to 6. If nothing else is found Roberta will purchase the black fabric from Joanns with a coupon.

There was discussion of whether to have the Quilt Show every other year. Pros and cons were talked about. It will definitely be held for 2024. We can bring up the questions with the guilds after the Quilt Show is over this year.

Meeting was adjourned.
