Northland Needlers Quilt Show Meeting Minutes

March 24, 2022

Meeting was call to order at 6:40 pm

Attendees: Debbie Davidson, Joann Thomas, Trudy Coogan, Roberta Waterfield, Leah Stanley, Vicki Nagayama, Gwen Weakley

Item 1: Open Positions that urgently need to be filled include: Nite Time Assistant co-chair

Nite Time Bazaar coordinator QS Secretary

Position that still need additional coordinators include Door Prizes, Quilt Registration and Quilt Release; however these can be filled closer to the show without negative effects.

Item 2: Updated procedures needed:

Bazaar, Quilt Registration, Silent Auction, Ribbons, Quilt Release The following has been updated: Treasurer

In addition, Vicki will update the Equipment file (in the QS Administration Dropbox that is separate from the annual show box) with invoice scans so that we have proof of purchase costs.

Mary Coogan has again volunteered to update the Quilt Registration form. She and Vicki will coordinate. QR code and forms should be available in June and will need to be completed by mid-July.

Item 3: Bazaar Trudy Coogan has volunteered her basement as the workspace for Bazaar. Workday will be on Tuesdays from 1 – 4 PM. However, first we will need to start collecting items for the bazaar at the Guild meetings.

Karen will need access to the storage to get Bazaar work tubs, tables etc. She and Vicki will coordinate a time.

Item 4: Publicity: Brenda Pfannenstiel did publicity last year, don't know if she is willing to do it this year. If not, that is another position that needs to be filled soon. We need to get some save the date cards to distribute since it is the beginning of guild quilt show season.

Item 5: Admission Price: We had discussion regarding the price of admission. Since we were able to retain the full \$10,000 for the show operations and return \$1566 to each guild, it was decided that there is no compelling reason to raise prices. One admission is \$5, 2 day pass \$7.

Item 6: 2022 Budget: Day guild board approved the budget in Mar during a Zoom meeting, Nite Time will discuss and vote at the Apr board meeting.

Other items for discussed:

1. Door Prizes: we have plenty of tickets between the 2 guilds.
2. Frames/Equipment: \$2000 was submitted for the budget, pending on NT board vote. Vicki will place orders when budget is approved.
3. Sponsors & Ads: with no program do we need? No coordinator volunteer.
4. Ribbons: Jean Newton will make ribbons again this year.
5. Signs & Logos: Phyllis Carlyle will continue in this position.
6. Silent Auction: Pam Peugh (NT) and Mary Anne Cohen (DT) volunteered to fill co-coordinator slots.
7. Vendor: Marci Hainkel is vendor chair. We currently on have 2 open slots.
8. Need a coordinator for Sign Up Genius. Will Check with JoAnn Borchelt to see if she is willing.

Discussed whether to have a meeting in April because it would be the week of the ASQ Paducah show. None of the attendees are going to it was decided to have a meeting on April 22 @ 6:30 pm at Gashland United Methodist.

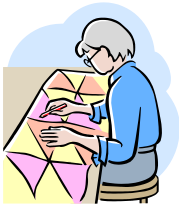
